Keney Park Local Rules

Play is governed by the 2019 Rules of Golf and its interpretations, the U.S. Kids Golf Foundation State Invitational Rules & Regulations, and by the following Local Rules:

- **RULES HOTLINE:** If during your round, you need a ruling or rules official assistance, please call the tournament rules hotline at **860-255-4012**. Cell phones may only be used by a player or caddie to contact the rules hotline or in emergency situations, use of cell phones/apps as a distance-measuring device/GPS is prohibited.
- **OUT OF BOUNDS:** #9 Out of Bounds is defined by the guardrail and the cart path leading from the clubhouse to the parking lot. #10 Out of Bounds is defined by the guardrail on the right. #12: Out of Bounds along the whole right side of the hole from the stone wall to around the green defined by the wall.
- **INTEGRAL PART OF COURSE:** The stone wall on the 12th has been deemed as “integral parts of the golf course” by the committee. As such, they are not considered to be obstructions and no relief will be granted.
- **STONES IN BUNKERS:** Stones in bunkers are deemed loose impediments, as are leaves, pine cones, and the like. Impediments may be removed from the bunker; however, the removal of the impediment must not cause the ball to move (*Rule 15.1*). •
- **MODEL LOCAL RULE G-9 – USGA local rule replacing broken or significantly damaged club, except in abuse, is in effect.**
- **PENALTY AREAS:** If the colour of a penalty area has not been marked or indicated by the committee, it is treated as a red penalty area.
- **CADDIE STANDING BEHIND LINE OF PLAY (R&A, and USGA Clarification):** Therefore, if a player takes a stance when the caddie is deliberately standing on or close to an extension of the line of play behind the ball, there is no penalty under Rule 10.2b(4) **if the player backs away from the stance and does not begin to take a stance for the stroke** that is actually made until after the caddie has moved out of that location. This applies anywhere on the course.
- **PENALTY AREAS:** When the edge of a body of water **is not defined by the Committee** (I.E. no lines or Stakes), the edge of that penalty area is defined by its natural boundaries (that is, where the ground slopes down to form the depression that can hold the water).
